SCHEDULE

ALL that area in the South Auckland Land District, the County of Tauranga and the Borough of Te Puke bounded by a line commencing at the intersection of the shore of the Bay of Plenty with the western boundary of Tumu Kaituna No. 14, Block V, Te Tumu S.D.; thence in a southerly direction along that boundary to the southernmost corner of Lot 101, D.P. S. 11068, Papamoa County Town; thence north-westerly generally along the north-eastern boundaries of Lot 1, D.P. S. 10261 and Lot 1, D.P. S. 10683 to the western boundary of that Lot, thence southerly along that boundary to the southernmost corner of Lot 1, D.P. S. 12192, and proceeding north-westerly generally along the south-western and north-western boundaries of Lot 1, D.P. S. 12192, to and along the south-western boundaries of Lots 14 to 1, D.P. S. 9722; thence south-westerly, north-westerly and north-easterly along the boundaries of D.P. S. 8870 to the southernmost corner of the service lane on D.P. S. 3395; thence north-westerly by a right line generally along the south-western boundary of D.P. S. 3396 to the south-western corner of Lot 53, D.P.
