REVIEW OF POWERS OF GOVERNMENT DEPARTMENTS AND ORGANISATIONS TO REQUIRE THE SUPPLY OF PERSONAL INFORMATION

SECTIONS 39 (b) and (c) of the Official Information Act 1982, require the authority:

To examine any existing or proposed powers of a department or organisation to require persons to supply information about themselves or any other person and to express its view or whether those powers are fair and reasonable;
