Emergency Restriction on Cut Flower Imports Plants Act 1970 (No. 3108, Ag. 12/2/12)

PURSUANT to section 6 of the Plants Act 1970, the Director-General hereby restricts the introduction into New Zealand of the following cut flowers from the specified regions of countries, unless the Director-General is satisfied the importations will not introduce into the country the specified pests and diseases not known to be present in New Zealand.

Carnation Chrysanthemum Gypsophila	North and South America, Europe, and Africa	Leaf miners, <i>Liriomyza trifolii</i> , <i>L. sativae</i> , <i>L. huidobrensis</i>
Gladiolus	All countries where rust diseases occur, including Mediterranean countries and Africa	Rust diseases, <i>Uromyces, gladioli</i> , <i>U. transversalis</i>
Roses	Japan	Rust disease, <i>Keuhneola japonica</i>

All imports of the above cut flowers shall be subject to prior approval by permit to import issued by the Officer-in-Charge, Plant Health and Diagnostic Station, Private Bag, Levin.
