GREETING:

WHEREAS, by Order in Council made on the 29th day of September 1982*, you, the said Peter Gordon Hillyer, Eric Alderson Missen, and Gideon Tait were appointed to be a Commission to inquire into and report upon the administration of the District Court at Wellington:

And whereas by the said Order in Council you were required to submit your January 1983: report not later than the 31st day

And whereas by a further Order in Council made on the 7th day of December 1982† the scope of the inquiry was altered and the time for so reporting was extended until the 31st day of March

And whereas it is expedient that the time for reporting should be further extended as hereinafter provided:

Now, therefore, I, Sir David Stuart Beattie, the Governor-General of New Zealand, acting pursuant to the Commissions of Inquiry Act 1908, and by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby extend until the 30th day of June 1983 the time within which you are so required to report without prejudice to the continuation of the liberty conferred on you by the said Order in Council made on the 29th day of September 1982* to report your proceedings and recommendations from time to time if you should judge it expedient so to do.

And I hereby confirm the said Order in Council and the Commission thereby constituted save as modified by the said Order in Council made on the 7th day of December 1982† and by these
