*Traffic Signs—Height Clearances at Rail Level Crossings*

NOTICE

PURSUANT to Regulation 129 (6) of the Traffic Regulations 1976,\* the Minister of Transport hereby approves the erection and maintenance of traffic signs, as described in the Schedule, for height clearance under overhead electrification at rail level crossings.

SCHEDULE

HEIGHT CLEARANCE AHEAD SIGN

*Shape and Size:* Circular, 600 mm diameter.

*Background Colour:* Reflectorised white.

*Border:* Reflectorised red, 50 mm wide.

*Legend:* Symbols and Numerals:

Circle segment pointing downwards above figures showing safe clearance in metres above circle segment pointing upwards.

*Colour and Size:*

Figures to be black, 150 mm high. Segments to be black, 90° arc, 100 mm high.

LIVE ELECTRICAL CABLE OVERHEAD SIGN

*Shape and Size:* Diamond, 600 mm sides.

*Background Colour:* Reflectorised yellow.

*Border:* Black, 15 mm wide.

*Legend:* Symbol:

A zigzag shaped arrow pointing downwards.

*Colour and Size:*

To be black, 600 mm high, stem width tapering from 120 mm at tail to 20 mm at base of head, head sides 140 mm.

**1. Title and commencement**—(1) This notice may be cited as the Civil Defence Regions Notice 1983.

(2) This notice shall come into force on the 14th day after the date of its publication in the *Gazette*.

**2. Civil defence regions**—For the purposes of the Civil Defence Act 1962, New Zealand is hereby declared to be divided into civil defence regions with the names and comprising the districts of the local authorities set out in the Schedule to this notice.
