

ALL that area, bounded by a line commencing at Trig 4, Belvedere Peak, Block IV, Humboldt Survey District, being a point on the south-western boundary of the Electoral District of Marlborough, hereinbefore described; and proceeding south-westerly generally along the summit of the Spenser Mountains and the Main Divide, being the common boundary with the Electoral District of West Coast, hereinbefore described, to the summit of the Dampier Range; thence south-easterly generally along that range to the summit of the Puketeraki Range; thence south-westerly generally along that range to Trig S (Black Hill) situated in Block IX, Upper Ashley Survey District; thence due west to the middle of the Waimakariri River; thence generally south-easterly down the middle of that river (the present course) to the mean high water mark of the South Pacific Ocean; thence north-easterly generally along that mean high water mark of the South Pacific Ocean to the south-western boundary of the Electoral District of Marlborough hereinbefore described; thence generally north-westerly along that boundary to the point of commencement; and including all adjacent islands.

CHRISTCHURCH NORTH

ALL that area, bounded by a line commencing at the mean high water mark of the South Pacific Ocean, being a point on the southern boundary of the Electoral District of Rangiora, hereinbefore described, and proceeding generally southerly along the mean high water mark of the South Pacific Ocean, to the middle of Rothesay Road; thence north-westerly and south-westerly along the middle of Rothesay Road, and the production of that road to the middle of Burwood Road; thence north-westerly, westerly, southerly along the middle of Burwood Road, Prestons Road, and Grimseys Road to the middle of Winters Road; thence westerly and southerly along the middle of Winters Road and Fraser Street to the middle of Cranford Street; thence south-easterly along the middle of that road to a point in line with the original north-western boundary of Lot 2, D.P. 13589; thence south-westerly to and along that original north-western boundary to the north-eastern boundary of part Rural Section 308 comprised in C.T. 20K/507; thence north-westerly and south-westerly along the north-eastern and north-western boundaries of that part rural section and the last-mentioned boundary produced across Grassmere Street to the northernmost corner of part of Rural Section 308 comprised in C.T. 23B/81; thence south-westerly and south-easterly along the north-western and south-western boundaries of the last-mentioned part Rural Section 308 to, and along the south-western boundaries of parts Rural Section 308 comprised in Cs. T. 392/41, 21K/289 and 143/258 and the last-mentioned boundary produced to the middle of Grants Road; thence generally south-westerly, along the middle of Grants Road, Papanui Road, Blighs Road, Wairakei Road, Ilam Road to and generally north-westerly along the middle of Brookside Terrace, Greens Road, Wairakei Road, Russey Road, Harewood Road, and McArthur's Road and the last-mentioned middle line produced to the middle of the old bed of the South Branch of the Waimakariri River; thence north-easterly along a right line between the last-mentioned intersection of middle lines and the middle of the south-western end of Baynons Road, to the middle of the Waimakariri River, being a point on the southern boundary of the Electoral District of Rangiora hereinbefore described; thence generally easterly along that southern boundary to the point of commencement.

ST. ALBANS

ALL that area, bounded by a line commencing at the middle line of Rothesay Road, at the western end of that road, being a point on the southern boundary of the Electoral District of Christchurch North, hereinbefore described; and proceeding south-easterly along a right line to the north-western corner of part Lot 1, D.P. 41182, contained in Gazette Notice 39167/11, thence southerly along the western boundaries of that part Lot 1, part Rural Section 32752, part Lot 2 and part Lot 1, D.P. 909, all contained in Gazette Notice 39167/11, and the last-mentioned boundary produced to the middle of Mairehau Road; thence generally south-westerly and south-easterly along the middle of Mairehau Road and Beach Road; thence generally southerly along the middle of Frosts Road, Travis Road, Barkers Road, and the production of the last-mentioned middle line to the middle of the Avon River; thence westerly up the middle of that river to a point in line with the western boundary of Lot 169, D.P. 41473; thence southerly to and along that western boundary and the western boundaries of Lots 138, 139, 149, 149, 152, D.P. 41473, Cowes Street and Lot 153, D.P. 39361 to the westernmost corner of the last-mentioned lot; thence westerly along a right line to the northernmost corner of part Lot 1, D.P. 9403 comprised in C.T. 15B/685; thence westerly and southerly along the northern and western boundaries of that part Lot 1 and the last-mentioned boundary produced to the middle of Breezes Road; thence westerly along that middle line and its production to the middle of the Avon River; thence generally westerly up the middle of that river (through Kerrs Reach) and Dudley Creek and the production of the last-mentioned middle line to a point in line with the middle of Averill Street; thence generally westerly to and along the middle of Averill Street, Stapletons Road, Guild Street, Hills Road, Edgeware Road, Abberly Crescent, St. Albans

South and the seaward side of No. 6 State Highway (Rocks Road) to its intersection with the production of a line bearing 123°42', distance 284.29 metres, as shown on S.O. Plan 8460; thence north-westerly by a right line to the low water mark at Wave Point on Haulashore Island; thence generally north-westerly along the seaward low water mark of Haulashore Island to the training wall on the southern side of the new entrance, along a line at right angles to the said training wall across the new entrance to the low water mark on the Boulder Bank, and along the seaward low water mark of the Boulder Bank to the point of commencement.

MARLBOROUGH

ALL that area lying above mean high water mark in Canterbury, Marlborough, and Nelson Land Districts, bounded by a line commencing at the intersection of mean high water mark and the middle of the Conway River, at the south-eastern corner of Block XXII, Hundalee Survey District and proceeding generally westerly and northerly along the middle of the Conway River to its source at Palmer Saddle in Block XI, Acheron Survey District; thence north-westerly along a right line to Mount Ross; thence due west to the middle of the Clarence River; thence generally south-westerly and northerly along the middle of the Clarence River to its outlet from Lake Tennyson in Block VIII, Maling Survey District and continuing generally northerly to and along the eastern shore of the said lake to a point in line with the north-western boundary of Section 6, Square 70 in Block IV, Maling Survey District; thence north-easterly to and along that boundary to the summit of the Crimea Range; thence generally northerly along the summits of the Crimea and St Arnaud Ranges through Belvedere Peak and Trig E, St Arnaud, to the south-eastern boundary of part Section 11, Block XIV, Motupiko Survey District; thence north-easterly along that boundary to the south-western boundary of part Section 6, Square 34; thence generally north-westerly along that boundary to the southern side of No. 63 State Highway; thence easterly along the southern side of that highway to its intersection with a right line between Trig Top 2, in Block III, Raglan Survey District, and Barefell Pass, in Block IV, Barefell Survey District; thence north-westerly along that right line to Trig Top 2; thence north-easterly along a right line to Wards Pass, in Block VII, Patriarch Survey District; thence generally north-easterly along the summit of the Richmond Range through Trig BC, Bishops Cap to Trig Mount Sunday in Block VI, Onamalutu Survey District; thence generally north-easterly along the watersheds between the Waikamarina and Kaituna Rivers and the Pelorus and Kaituna Rivers to the south-eastern boundary of Section 1 of 5, Block XII, Wakamarina Survey District; thence north-easterly and easterly along that boundary and the southern boundaries of Sections 2 of 5 and 3 of 5, Block XII, aforesaid to peg VIII, S.O. 530; thence easterly along a right line to the north-western corner of Section 1, Block XII, aforesaid; thence easterly along the northern boundary of the said section and its production to the western boundary of Lot 1, D.P. 3385; thence northerly along the said western boundary to the north-western corner of that lot; thence north-westerly along a right line to the western boundary of part Block A, (Harbour Board Endowment); thence generally northerly along that boundary to the south-eastern corner of Section 44, Town of Havelock; thence northerly along the eastern boundary of that section to mean high water mark as defined on S.O. 4502; thence easterly and north-westerly along that mean high water mark to the south-eastern boundary of Havelock Quay as defined on S.O. 4502; thence north-easterly along that boundary to the south-western boundary of part Block A, edged yellow on S.O. 4502; thence south-easterly along that boundary and generally northerly along the eastern boundary of the said part Block A to the eastern boundary of another part Block A as defined on S.O. 5666; thence northerly along that boundary to the southernmost corner of Section 235, Town of Havelock; thence easterly and northerly along the southern and eastern boundaries of that section to the southern side of Cook Street; thence north-easterly along the south-eastern boundary of that street to the easternmost corner of part Section 1, Town of Havelock; thence north-westerly along the north-eastern boundary of the said section to its northernmost corner; thence north-easterly along a right line to the western extremity of Cullen Point in Block VIII, Wakamarina Survey District; thence due north to the middle of Pelorus Sound; thence generally easterly, northerly, north-easterly, westerly, and north-easterly along the middle of Pelorus Sound (passing east of Maud Island) to a point 5 kilometres due south of another point bearing 45° and 3.2 kilometres distant from Harding Point; thence due north to the last-mentioned point, in Block XXVI, Gore Survey District; thence north-easterly along a right line to the intersection of parallel of latitude 40°30' south with meridian of longitude 174°30' east; thence southerly along that meridian of longitude to a point due east of the southernmost corner of Section 4, Block XIV, Arapawa Survey District; thence due west to mean high water mark; thence generally south-westerly along mean high water mark, including the mouths of all rivers, harbours, inlets and all adjacent islands and rocks to the point of commencement.
