thence generally south-easterly along that watershed to Simonin Pass; thence southerly along a right line to the confluence of Limbo Stream and the Cascade River; thence southerly along the middle of Limbo Stream to a point in line with the leading north-westerly ridge from Picador, situated in Humboldt Survey District; thence south-easterly to and along that leading ridge to Picador; thence easterly along the watershed of Retreat Creek and Limbo Stream passing through Mataora to Toreador Peak on the summit of the Olivine Range; thence generally south-westerly along the summit of the Olivine Range passing through Persephone Col, Typhoon Peak, Holloway Peak, Mount Temple, Invitation Col, Trinity, Trinity Pass, Gortzen River Col, Blockade Peak, Key Rock, Mount Gates, and Possibility Col to Albert Peak on the summit of the Barrier Range; thence generally south-westerly along the watershed of the Forgiven and Dart Rivers passing through Betty Peak, Mallory Peak, and Irvine Peak to Terminal Peak; thence south-westerly along a right line to Brenda Peak; thence generally south-westerly along the watershed of the Hollyford and Dart Rivers; passing through Fohn Peak, Fohn Saddle, Tantalus Peak, Niobe Peak, Poseidon Peak, Park Pass, Neruus Peak, North Col, Conical Hill, Harris Saddle, Trig N, Ocean Peak, and Emily Pass to Emily Peak; thence generally south-westerly along the main ridge of the Ailsa Mountains to a point due east of the Greenstone Saddle; thence due west through that saddle to the summit of the Livingstone Mountains; thence southerly along that summit to the north-western corner of Run 756, situated in Upper Wakatipu and Von Survey Districts; thence generally southerly and south-easterly along the generally western and south-western boundaries of Run 736 aforesaid, to an unnamed peak at grid reference 119780 (N.Z.M.S. 1, S131); thence south-easterly along a right line to an unnamed peak at the grid reference 131765 (N.Z.M.S. 1, S131); thence generally south-easterly along the watershed of the Mararoa and Greenstone Rivers to the summit of the Thomson Mountains; thence generally southerly along that summit through grid reference 240636 (N.Z.M.S. 1, S131), to the unnamed peak at grid reference 176549 (N.Z.M.S. 1, S131); thence generally southerly along the watershed between the Oreti and Von Rivers passing through Trig L, Mount Lookup, and Trig J, Block X, Mavora Survey District, to Hummock Peak; thence south-easterly, easterly, and north-easterly along right lines to Jane Peak, Eyre Peak, and James Peak situated in Nevis Survey District; thence generally southerly along the summit of the Hector Mountains, passing through Lorn Peak, Trig G, Kingston Survey District, and Trig H, Tennants Peak and the summit of Slate Range to the intersection of the last-mentioned summit with the middle of the Garston Nevis Road, being a common point on the generally northern boundary of the Electoral District of Clutha, hereinafter described; thence generally easterly and south-easterly along the generally northern and north-eastern boundaries of the Electoral District of Clutha to the confluence of Lec Stream and the Taieri River, situated on the north-western boundary of Block 1, Dunedin and East Taieri Survey District; thence generally north-easterly up the middle of the Taieri River to a point due west of Trig S, Swampy Spur; thence due east to Trig S; thence southerly along the eastern boundary of Section 3, Block V, Dunedin and East Taieri Survey District, and its production to the northernmost corner of Section 8, Block V, aforesaid; thence south-easterly along the south-eastern boundaries of Sections 11, 10, and 9, Block V, aforesaid, and the production of the last-mentioned boundary to the middle of Cedar Road; thence north-westerly along the middle of that road to a point in line with the eastern boundary of Section 55, Block V, aforesaid; thence southerly to and along the eastern boundaries of Sections 55 and 54, Block V, Dunedin and East Taieri Survey District, to the southernmost corner of the last-mentioned section; thence south-easterly along the north-eastern boundary of Section 53, Block V, aforesaid, to the easternmost corner of that section, being a common point on the northern boundary of the Electoral District of Dunedin North; thence generally south-easterly along the generally north-eastern boundary of the Electoral District of Dunedin North to the mean high water mark of the Otago Harbour; thence generally north-easterly along the mean high water mark of the Otago Harbour, and the sea, to a point in line with the middle of Awamoa Central Road, situated in Block IV, Oamaru Survey District; thence generally north-westerly to and north-westerly and north-easterly along the middle of that road and Oamaru-Kakanui Road to a point in line with the north-eastern boundary of Lot 1, D.P. 13762; thence north-westerly to and along that boundary to the northernmost corner of Lot 1; thence north-easterly and northerly along the south-eastern and eastern boundaries of Lot 3, D.P. 5893, and the eastern boundary of Lot 11, D.P. 1617, and the production of the last-mentioned boundary to the middle of No. 1 State Highway; thence generally south-westerly along the middle of that State Highway, and its production to the western side of the Main South Railway; thence south-westerly along the middle of No. 1 State Highway to the middle of White Rocks Road; thence northerly along the middle of White Rocks Road to its intersection with the southern boundary of Block III, Oamaru Survey District; thence westerly along that boundary and its production to the middle of the Waiakeka Stream; thence generally northerly up the middle of that stream to its intersection with the northern boundary of Block IX, Oamaru Survey

the eastern boundaries of that block and Block XV, Waitemo Survey District, to the intersection of the last-mentioned boundary with the northern boundary of Run 209; thence westerly and generally south-westerly along the northern and generally north-western boundaries of that run to its westernmost corner; thence generally south-westerly along the generally north-western boundary of Run 700 to the intersection of that boundary with the summit of the Horse Range, being a point distant 800 metres, approximately, from the northernmost corner of Section 31, Block VIII, Waitemo Survey District; thence generally north-westerly along the summit of that range to Trig C situated in Block IX, Waitemo Survey District; thence generally north-westerly along the generally south-western boundaries of Run 699, Block IX, Run 572, Block XI, Waitemo Survey District, and Run 571, Block XI, Waitemo Survey District to the southern boundary of Kakanui Survey District; thence generally westerly and north-westerly along the generally southern and south-western boundaries of Kakanui Survey District to Trig A, Kakanui Peak, Swinburn Survey District; thence generally north-westerly along the generally south-western boundary of part Run 681 situated in Block IX, Kakanui Survey District and its production to the middle of an unnamed road forming the north-eastern boundaries of Runs 206E, Block III, Swinburn Survey District, 206D Block III, Swinburn and Block XIV, Kyebrum Survey Districts, and 736 Block XI, Kyebrum Survey District; thence north-westerly along the middle of that road to Trig I, Mount Nobbler, Block XI, Kyebrum Survey District; thence along a right line bearing 6°03' to the generally western boundary of Run 510, Block XIII, Swinburn Survey District; thence generally northerly along that boundary and its productions across an unnamed road to the generally eastern boundary of Block IX, Kyebrum Survey District; thence generally northerly along the generally eastern boundary of that block to its intersection with the watershed passing through Section 1, Block IX, aforesaid, being a point distant 390 metres, approximately, south-westward from Trig Y, Kyebrum Survey District; thence south-westerly and northerly along that watershed to its intersection with the generally northern boundary of Section 1, Block IX, Kyebrum Survey District; thence generally westerly and south-westerly along the generally northern and north-western boundaries of Section 1, aforesaid, to the intersection of the last-mentioned boundary with the watershed passing through the south-western corner of part Run 574; being a point distant 1000 metres, approximately, northward from Trig N, Mount Kyebrum; thence generally westerly along that watershed to its intersection with the generally south-eastern boundary of part Run 573 (3763.5765 hectares) situated in Mount Buster Survey District; thence generally south-westerly and westerly along the generally south-eastern and southern boundaries of that part run to Trig M, Mount Buster; thence generally westerly along the generally southern boundaries of parts Run 573 situated in Mount Buster, Kyebrum, and Naseby Survey Districts, to Trig I, Mount Ida; thence generally north-westerly along the summit of the Hawkdun Range to the intersection of that summit with the southern boundary of Gala Survey District; thence westerly along the southern boundaries of Gala and Hawkdun Survey Districts to the intersection of the last-mentioned boundary with the western boundary of Run 201F; thence generally northerly along the generally western boundaries of Runs 201F, 201E, 201G, and 201B situated in Hawkdun Survey District, to the westernmost corner of the last-mentioned run; thence generally south-westerly along a leading ridge through Old Man Peak to Linds Pass; thence generally north-westerly along the summit of the range passing through Trig N, Linds Survey District, Trig R2, Longslip Mountain, Longslip Survey District, Dromedary Hill, Trig H2, Longslip Survey District, Pavilion Peak, Mount Melina, Mount Martha, Birch Hill, Trig O, Longslip Survey District, Trig A, Mount Gladwish, Trigs D and E, Stafford Survey District, Mount Rigel, Mount Barth, and Mount Huxley to Mount Strauchon on the summit of the Southern Alps; thence north-easterly along the Summit of the Southern Alps to McClure Peak, Block IV, Torlesse Survey District, being a common point on the south-eastern boundary of the Electoral District of West Coast and the south-western boundary of the Electoral District of Ashburton, hereinafter described; thence south-easterly along the south-western boundaries of the Electoral Districts of Ashburton, aforesaid, and Timaru, hereinafter described, to the mean high water mark of the South Pacific Ocean; thence generally southerly along that mean high water mark to the point of commencement.
