Tairawhiti Community College Notice 1983

PURSUANT to section 69 of the Education Act 1964, the Minister of Education gives the following notice.

NOTICE

1. (1) This notice may be cited as the Tairawhiti Community College Notice 1983.

(2) This notice shall come into force on the date of its publication in the *Gazette*.

2. In this notice, unless the context otherwise requires, "East Coast region" means that part of the North Island of New Zealand within the counties of Cook, Waiapu, Waikohu, Wairoa, the borough of Wairoa, and the city of Gisborne.

3. There shall be a board of governors to be known as the Tairawhiti Community College Council which shall control the Tairawhiti Community College.

4. The Tairawhiti Community College Council shall be constituted as follows:

- (a) One member appointed jointly by the Gisborne City Council, the Cook County Council, and the Gisborne High Schools Board;
- (b) One member appointed jointly by the Wairoa Borough Council, the Wairoa County Council, and the Wairoa College Board of Governors;
- (c) One member appointed jointly by the Waiapu County Council and the Ngata Memorial College Committee of Management;
- (d) One member appointed jointly by the Waikohu County Council and the Waikohu College Committee of Management;
- (e) One member, who shall be resident in the East Coast region, appointed by the Hawke's Bay Education Board;
- (f) One member, who shall be resident in the East Coast region, jointly appointed by the Wellington District Employers' Association (Gisborne Branch), the Gisborne Chamber of
