†On 1 April 1982 the New Zealand Railways Department became a Corporation under the provisions of the New Zealand Railways Corporation Act 1981. Section 36 of the Act provides for the capital of the Corporation to be determined from 1 April 1982 by Order in Council at which time the liability of the Corporation to repay advances is extinguished. The capital was determined by Order in Council on 21 June 1982.
