Pursuant to section 63B (2) of the Forests Act 1949, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby declares that the area of State

forest land described in the Schedule hereto, having been set apart as part of Pureora State Forest Park by a Proclamation published in *New Zealand Gazette*, 1978, page 2463 hereby ceases to be part of Pureora State Forest Park as from the date of publication hereof.

SOUTH AUCKLAND LAND DISTRICT—OTOROHANGA DISTRICT

21.0430 hectares, more or less, being Section 17, Block XIII and Sections 50, 51, and 54, Block IX, Wharepapa Survey District. Part New Zealand Gazettes, 1964, page 1556, and 1965, page 1719, as shown on plans S16/5, S16/6, and S16/7. (S.O. 52043, 52044, and 52045.)
