PURSUANT to regulation 17 of the Import Control Regulations 1973*, the Minister of Trade and Industry hereby gives notice as follows: 1. (a) This notice may be cited as the Import Control Exemption Notice (No. 5) 1984-85.

(b) This notice shall come into force on the 1st day of July 1984.
