- (3) That prior to making each such distribution the directors shall transfer from the revenue reserves of the company to the capital replacement fund in the company's accounts an amount equal to the amount to be distributed, such fund not to be available for the payment of dividends nor without the approval of the High Court for distribution to shareholders but may be applied in paying up unissued shares of the company as fully paid bonus shares.
