Administration of the Government of the Cook Islands

The Right Honorable Sir Peter Dunsford, Governor-General, has the honor to announce that the Cook Islands (Administration of the Government) Bill 1984 has passed the House of Representatives on the 27th day of October 1984. The Bill provides for the establishment of a Council of Ministers and the appointment of a Prime Minister and Deputy Prime Minister. It also provides for the appointment of a Minister of Finance and a Minister of Health. The Bill is now being considered by the House of Representatives.
