7. The annual basic and water availability charges shall be reduced for the first six seasons of supply as shown in the Third Schedule. The reductions, together with the interest thereon, shall be debited to the appropriate scheme account, and recovered over the subsequent 24 years.

8. The water for the scheme is to be taken from an existing reservoir on the Waipapa Stream and will maintain a piped supply of irrigation water at a minimum pressure of 150 kilopascals to 939 hectares of irrigable land in the District for the irrigation of sub-tropical fruits. The works are capable of supplying 2500 cubic metres of water per irrigable hectare per season at a maximum rate of 3.5 millimetres over a 24-hour period.

9. The charges have been based on the total estimated headworks and off-orchard costs plus the costs of operation, maintenance and renewals and the demand for water, as stated under sections 209 and 211 of the Public Works Act 1981, and shall be subject to adjustment at the commencement of the availability of supply, at the end of the seventh season of availability of supply, and every 2 years thereafter to compensate for any difference in any element of these charges as allowed for under sections 210 and 212 of the Public Works Act 1981.

10. The season shall be that period commencing on the 15th day of September and ending on the 30th day of April next following.

11. The minimum aggregate area of land occupied by any occupier that is to be included in the District shall be eight (8) hectares.

FIRST SCHEDULE

WATER SUPPLY WORKS

THE Kapiro - Pungaere Irrigation Scheme headworks comprise firstly the diversions and impoundments on the Pungaere Stream; secondly the conveyancing waterworks including pipes that take water to the start of the reticulation works and thirdly the pressure boosting works necessary to maintain the minimum supply pressure. Much of the headworks are shared with the Kerikeri Irrigation Scheme. The off-orchard works comprise the piped reticulation and associated works necessary to distribute irrigation water to orchard boundaries. The said works include all dams, reservoirs, weirs, pipes, valves, pumps, meters and all other works incidental to and required for the construction, maintenance and control of the said works for the irrigation district.

The on-orchard works comprise the works necessary to distribute water from the orchard boundary as defined in individual orchard plans prepared for each property.
