*Declaring Easement Over Land Acquired for Soil Conservation and River Control Purposes in Block IV, Te Mata Survey District, Hawke's Bay County*

PURSUANT to section 20 of the Public Works Act 1981, the Minister of Works and Development declares that, an agreement to that effect having been entered into, an easement in gross (flood detention dam) is hereby acquired over the land described in the Schedule hereto, for soil conservation and river control purposes vesting in the Crown (called the grantee) on the 5th day of April 1984, together with the right of the grantee and its agents to do and carry out the following over the said land:
