- (e) One member appointed by the Auckland District Maori Council;
- (f) One member appointed by the Pacific Islands Educational Resource Centre Management Advisory Committee.
- (g) One member to be co-opted by the Board of Governors itself, if and when it thinks fit.

3. The term of office of all existing members of the Nga Tapuwae College Board of Governors shall cease on the 31st day of July 1985 and the term of the new board, appointed and elected pursuant to clause 2 of this notice shall commence on the 1st day of August 1985.
