

11. Creditors—Subject to section 37F of the Local Government Act 1974, the rights or interests of creditors of the Ohaupo and Ngaroto Drainage Districts shall not be affected.

12. Rating—The classification of land for rating purposes in the Ohaupo Drainage District shall remain in force in the Ohaupo subdivision of the united district and the classification of land for rating purposes in the Ngaroto Drainage District shall remain in force for the Ngaroto subdivision of the united district.
