

The Traffic (Taurarunui County) Notice No. 1, 1985

PURSUANT to the Transport Act 1962, a delegation from the Minister of Transport, and a subdelegation from the Secretary for Transport, I, Carne Maurice Clissold, Chief Traffic Engineer, give the following notice:

NOTICE

THIS notice may be cited as the Traffic (Taurarunui County) Notice No. 1, 1985.

The roads specified in the Schedule are declared to be closely populated localities for the purposes of section 52 of the Transport Act 1962.

The notice under section 52 of the Transport Act 1962, dated the 26th day of August 1965*, which relates to roads situated within Taurarunui County at National Park, is revoked.

Carrol Street: from the North Island Main Trunk Railway to No. 4 State Highway (Te Kuiti - Wanganui via Raetihi).

Millar Street: from Ward Street to No. 4 State Highway (Te Kuiti - Wanganui via Raetihi).

Railway Road.

Turner Place.

Ward Street.
