EXPLANATORY NOTE: This exemption notice provides for exemption of:

- (a) Flameproof lamps and lighting fittings;
- (b) Power take-off shafts and parts thereof;
- (c) Certain battery chargers;
- (d) Other electrical appliances, e.g. floor polishers, etc;
- (e) Other electrical goods, e.g. radio navigational aid apparatus, etc;
- (f) Portable tape-recorders for use only with headsets;
- (g) Blank mini- and micro-cassettes for use in dictating machines;
- (h) Widens the exemption for road graders; and
- (i) Amends other exemptions to maintain alignment with the Customs Tariff.
