PRIVATE ACT

TAKE notice that the Council of Governors of Nelson College intends to apply for leave to promote a Private Act of Parliament which has the following objectives:

- To sell or otherwise dispose of the land described below by private Treaty Public Tender or in such other manner as it thinks fit on such terms and conditions as it thinks fit.
- To apply the proceeds of the sale or other disposal towards the costs of building and equipping a new gymnasium at Nelson College.
- To empower the District Land Registrar to register a Transfer of the land pursuant to the sale or other disposal.
