*Local Authorities Loans Act 1956—Conditions Applicable to Loans Which are Subject to the Local Authorities Loans Exemption Order 1985*

PURSUANT to section 3A (3) of the Local Authorities Loans Act 1956 (as inserted by section 3 of the Local Authorities Loans Amendment Act 1982) notice is hereby given that the Local Authorities Loans Board (the "Board") has determined as follows:

The determination made by the Board and published in the *Gazette* on the 17th day of March 1983 at page 764, as amended by further determinations made by the Board and published in the *Gazette* on the 13th day of September 1984, the 8th day of November 1984, and the 13th day of December 1984 at pages 3708, 4797 and 5685, respectively shall:

- Apply (except as set out in subclause (b) hereof) to all money which any local authority may borrow by way of special loan and for which pursuant to the Local Authorities Loans Exemption Order 1985 it is exempted from obtaining the sanction of the Board and the consent of the Minister of Finance;
- Not apply except in respect of clause 11 of the determination made by the Board and published in the *Gazette* on the 17th day of March 1983 at page 764, to special loans wholly funded by the Housing Corporation of New Zealand or the Rural Banking and Finance Corporation of New Zealand.
