The Milk Price Notice 1985 (No. 2) No. 3552; (Ag. 4/51/12/5)

PURSUANT to section 25 of the Milk Act 1967, the Minister of Agriculture hereby gives the following notice.

NOTICE

1. Title and commencement—(1) This notice may be cited as the Milk Price Notice 1985 (No. 2) and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Milk Price Notice 1980* (hereinafter referred to as the principal notice).

(2) This notice shall come into force on the 1st day of September 1985.

2. Maximum price for milk sold to consumers and commercial users—The principal notice is hereby amended by revoking the First Schedule, and substituting the First Schedule set out in the Schedule to this notice.

3. Maximum price at which milk may otherwise be sold—The principal notice is hereby amended by revoking the Second Schedule, and substituting the Second Schedule set out in the Schedule to this notice.

4. Revocation—The Milk Price Notice 1985† is hereby consequentially revoked.
