NOTICE

1. Title and commencement—(1) This notice may be cited as the Electoral Main Rolls Closing Notice 1985.

(2) This notice shall come into force on the day after the date of its publication in the *Gazette*.

2. Date for closing of main rolls—The main roll for every general electoral district and for every Maori electoral district shall close on the 4th day of October 1985.

EXPLANATORY NOTE
