

Import Control Exemption Notice (No. 20) 1985-86

PURSUANT to regulation 17 of the Import Control Regulations 1973*, the Minister of Trade and Industry hereby gives the following notice:

NOTICE

1. (1) This notice may be cited as the Import Control Exemption Notice (No. 20) 1985-86.
- (2) This notice shall come into force on the 27th day of September 1985.
2. Goods of the classes specified and for the purposes of the Customs Tariff falling within the tariff items in the First Schedule hereto, imported from and being the produce or manufacture of any country, are hereby exempted from the requirement of a licence under the said regulations.
3. The exemptions from the requirement of a licence under the said regulations in respect of the classes of goods set forth in the Second Schedule hereto, included in the exemption notices shown in the Second Schedule, are hereby withdrawn.
4. The exemptions from the requirement of a licence under the said regulations in respect of the classes of goods set forth in the Third Schedule hereto, imported from and being the produce or manufacture of Australia, included in the exemption notices shown in the Third Schedule, are hereby withdrawn.

EXPLANATORY NOTE: This notice provides for the exemption of:

- (a) slides, for image projectors;
- (b) cellular wood in sheets, etc.;
- (c) "improved" wood in sheets, etc.;
- (d) jewellery incorporating greenstone, etc.;
- (e) imitation jewellery incorporating fired clay;
- (f) casks, drums, etc. of iron or steel exceeding 30 litre capacity;
- (g) reservoirs, tanks, etc. of aluminium exceeding 300 litres;
- (h) casks, drums, etc. of aluminium exceeding 1 litre capacity.
