to the middle of Campbell Road; thence north-easterly along the middle of that road for a distance of 1 kilometre; thence south-easterly along a line parallel to and 1 kilometre distant from Campbell Road to its intersection with the middle of the Whakahaupapa Stream; then south-easterly up the middle of that stream to its intersection with Campbell Road; thence south-easterly to and along the middle of that road to its intersection with the middle of Pikowai Road; thence north-easterly along that road to its intersection with the middle of Settlement Road; thence easterly by a right line to a point being the intersection of the Herepuru Stream and the production of the northern boundary of Section 8, Block XII, Waihi South Survey District; thence generally southerly up the Herepuru Stream, and Waipapa Stream to a point 1 kilometre north of Manawahe Road; thence generally north-easterly parallel to and 1 kilometre distant from Manawahe Road and the Hereperu Road to its intersection with the middle of the East Coast Main Trunk Railway; thence south-easterly along the middle of that Railway to the point of commencement.

- 4. No vehicle shall stop, stand, or park on the portion of highway described above, except heavy motor vehicles as defined in the Heavy Motor Vehicle Regulations 1974.
- 5. Every person who commits an offence against this bylaw is liable on summary conviction to a fine not exceeding \$200 (two hundred dollars).
