Notice of Intention to Issue a Proclamation Closing Roads in the Towns of Lyell and Pensiniville and Vesting Them in Her Majesty The Queen as Crown Land Subject to the Land Act 1948

DAVID BEATTIE, Governor-General A PROCLAMATION

PURSUANT to section 10 of the Reserves and Other Lands Disposal Act 1962, I, The Honourable Sir David Stuart Beattie, the Governor-General of New Zealand, hereby give notice that it is my intention, after the expiration of 3 months from the date hereof, to issue a Proclamation closing the roads described in the Schedule hereto and declaring them to be vested in Her Majesty the Queen as Crown land, subject to the Land Act 1948.

Plans showing the roads are deposited in the office of the Commissioner of Crown Lands, Nelson, and the Head Office, Department of Lands and Survey, Wellington, where they may be inspected during office hours free of charge.

Any objections to the proposal are to be made in writing addressed to the Commissioner of Crown Lands, Nelson, on or before the 25th day of December 1985.

NELSON LAND DISTRICT—TOWNS OF LYELL AND PENSINIVILLE—BULLER COUNTY

FIRSTLY, 2.4548 hectares, being roads adjoining or passing through Sections 69 to 108 (inclusive), 110 to 130 (inclusive), 135, 137, 139, 142, 144, 146, part Sections 66 to 68 (inclusive), 132, 133, 138, 140 and 145, Town of Lyell, part Section 16, Square 139 and part Section 17, Square 139, situated in Block I, Maruia Survey District.
