ELIZABETH THE SECOND, by the Grace of God Queen of New Zealand and Her Other Realms and Territories, Head of the Commonwealth, Defender of the Faith:

To Our Trusty and Well-beloved The Most Reverend Sir Paul Alfred Reeves, Knight Grand Cross of Our Most Distinguished Order of Saint Michael and Saint George:

GREETING!

- I. We do by this Our Commission under the Seal of New Zealand, appoint you, The Most Reverend Sir Paul Alfred Reeves, to be, during Our pleasure, Our Governor-General and Commander-in-Chief in and over Our Realm of New Zealand.
- II. And We do hereby authorise and empower you to exercise the powers and authorities conferred on Our Governor-General and Commander-in-Chief by Our Letters Patent under the Seal of New Zealand bearing date the 28th day of October 1983 and constituting the office of Governor-General and Commander-in-Chief of New Zealand, or by any other Letters Patent altering, amending, or substituting for the same.
- III. And do hereby command you to do and execute those powers and authorities according to—
 - (a) The tenor of the said Letters Patent and of this Our Commission; and
 - (b) Such laws as are now or shall hereafter be in force in Our Realm of New Zealand or in any part thereof.
- IV. And We do hereby declare that this Our Commission shall take effect on the 20th day of November 1985.
