1. This notice may be cited as the Road Classification (Takapuna City) Notice No. 1 1985.

Inga Road: from Omana Road to Beach Road.

Kaimahi Road (all from Target Road).

Kitchener Road: from Hurstmere Road to East Coast Road.

Lake Road: from the Devonport Borough boundary to Anzac Street.

Marken Place (all from Ashfield Road).

Milford Road: from Kitchener Road to Ihumata Road.

Northcote Road: from the Northcote Borough boundary to Taharoto Road.

Omana Road: from Ihumata Road to Inga Road.

Parkway Drive: from Ramp Road to Constellation Drive.

Parity Place (all from Sunnybrae Road).

Poland Road (all from Archers Road to Hillside Road).

Porana Road (all from Wairau Road to Sunnybrae Road).
