*The Ohinemuri County Council Foreshore Control Order 1985*

## ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government Buildings at Wellington this 4th day  
of March 1985

Present:

THE HON. R. O. DOUGLAS PRESIDING IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to section 165 of the Harbours Act 1950, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

## ORDER

**1. Title and commencement**—(1) This order may be cited as the Ohinemuri County Council Foreshore Control Order 1985.

(2) This order shall come into force on the 1st day of April 1985.

**2. Interpretation**—In this order:

“The Act” means the Harbours Act 1950;

“The Council” means the Ohinemuri County Council constituted under the Local Government Act 1974;

“Foreshore” means such parts of the bed, shore, or banks of a tidal water as are covered and uncovered by the flow and ebb of the tide at ordinary spring tides.

**3. Grant of Control**—There is hereby granted to the Council for a period of 21 years from the 1st day of April 1985 and ending with the 31st day of March 2006 control of the foreshore described in the Schedule to this order.

**4. Conditions of Grant**—The grant of control conferred by clause 3 of this order is subject to the following conditions:

(a) Suitably worded signs shall be erected at main public access ways to the foreshore described in the Schedule to this order indicating that control of the foreshore has been granted to the Council pursuant to section 165 of the Act.

(b) All money received by the Council in the performance or exercise of the functions, duties or powers, be applied to the construction, repair or improvement of facilities in respect of that foreshore and not otherwise.

## SCHEDULE

ALL that area of foreshore commencing at the true left bank of the mouth of Te Ramarama River and proceeding generally southwards to the eastern extension of the southern boundary of Whangamata 6B3B1, Block 1, Waihi North Survey District.

The above area is more particularly shown coloured yellow on plan M.D. 16289, deposited in the office of the Secretary for Transport at Wellington.
