Exemption of Land From Mining

PURSUANT to section 24 (1) (a) of the Mining Act 1971, the Minister of Energy hereby gives the following notice—

NOTICE

THE land described in the Schedule hereto is hereby exempted from section 69 of the Mining Act 1971 in respect of the grant of mining licences which would permit mining operations to be carried out by or as part of a large scale opencast mining operation, or by or as part of any mining operation that forms part of a large scale opencast mining operation.

In this notice, the term "large scale opencast mining operation" means any opencast mining operation that involves or will involve the removal or excavation of more than a total of 100 000 tonnes in any 1 year of overburden, rock, ore, mineral deposit, or other material.

Plans of the area to which this notice relates are held by the Chief Surveyor, Hamilton; the Inspector of Mines, Huntly; and the Deputy Secretary of Energy (Mines), Wellington.

This notice shall come into force on the date of its publication in the *Gazette* and shall remain in force for a period of 18 months from that date and shall then expire.
