

north-easterly along said side to the westernmost corner of Lot 490, D.P. 7511, along the south-western boundary of said Lot 490 to and southerly south-easterly and north-easterly along the generally southern boundary of Lot 1, D.P. 3844 (Riccarton Bush) to the western side of Kauri Street; thence northerly along said side and the western boundary of Lot 375, D.P. 11261 to the north-western corner of said Lot 375; thence north-easterly along the north-western boundaries of said Lot 375 and Lots 376, 377, 378, 379, 380, 381, 517, 518, 519 and 520 of D.P. 11261 and the last-mentioned boundary produced across Rimu Street to the middle of Straven Road; thence north-easterly along the middle of that road to the middle of Avon River, thence generally north-easterly along the middle of said river to a point in line with the middle line of Deans Avenue; thence southerly to and along the middle of Deans Avenue; to the middle line of Moorhouse Avenue, easterly along the middle line of Moorhouse Avenue to a point in line with the middle line of Lincoln Road; thence south-westerly to and along the middle line of Lincoln Road to a point in line with the south-western boundary of Lot 2, D.P. 22425; thence north-westerly to and along that boundary and the south-western boundaries of Lot 1, D.P. 22425, Lots 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, 10 and 11, D.P. 2851, Lots 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, 10, 11, 12, 27, 13, 14, 15, 16, 17, 18 and 19 of D.P. 1961, part Rural Section 118, Lots 61, 60, Part 59 and Part 58 of D.P. 280, another part Rural Section 118, Lot 42, D.P. 280, Lot 34, D.P. 409 and another part Rural Section 118 to the south-eastern boundary of part Rural Section 145; thence south-westerly along said south-eastern boundary to a point in line with the western boundary of Lot 1, D.P. 41319, thence northerly to and along that boundary and that boundary produced to the middle of Princess Street; thence south-westerly along the middle line of Princess Street to a point in line with the middle line of Dalgety Street; thence northerly to and along the middle line of Dalgety Street to the middle line of Blenheim Road; thence south-westerly along the middle line of Blenheim Road, to the point of commencement. The said area of Riccarton Borough Council area of supply being more particularly shown on the plan marked NZE 2083 (sheets 1-20) deposited in the office of the Electricity Division of the Ministry of Energy at Wellington.

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Taupo Borough Council Electricity Supply Licence 1985

I, Robert James Tizard, Minister of Energy, acting pursuant to section 20 of the Electricity Act 1968 hereby license Taupo Borough Council hereinafter called the Electrical Supply Authority to supply electricity, and to lay, construct, put up, place and use all electric lines and works which may from time to time be required for the distribution and supply of electricity within the area specified in the Schedule hereto.

This licence is issued subject to the following conditions:

CONDITIONS

1. This licence may be cited as the Taupo Borough Council Electricity Supply Licence 1985.

2. The Electrical Supply Authority shall comply with the provisions of this licence, the Electricity Act 1968 and all enactments made in amendment of or substitution for that Act, any Electrical Codes of Practice made under that Act, the Electrical Supply Regulations 1984, the Electrical Wiring Regulations 1976 and all regulations made in amendment of or substitution for any of those regulations.

3. Any notice to be given to the Electrical Supply Authority shall be sufficient if sent by registered post to the offices of the Electrical Supply Authority.

4. Any notice to be given on the part of the Minister of Energy shall be sufficient if given in writing signed by the Minister or by any person purporting to act on behalf of or under the authority of the Minister.

5. Any notice to be given to the Minister of Energy shall be sufficient if given in writing to or sent by registered post letter addressed to the Secretary of Energy, Ministry of Energy, Wellington.

6. This licence shall not be construed as granting a consent to generate electricity pursuant to section 25 of the Electricity Act 1968.

7. This licence shall come into force on the 1st day of April 1985 and shall continue in force for a period of 21 years from that date unless it is sooner lawfully determined in accordance with clauses 8 or 9 hereof.

8. The Governor-General in Council may pursuant to section 22 of the Electricity Act 1968 cancel this licence if the Electrical Supply Authority is in breach of the provisions contained in clause 2 of these conditions.

9. This licence may be cancelled by the Minister of Energy at the request of or with the consent of the Electrical Supply Authority.

10. At the expiry or cancellation of this licence, the Electrical Supply Authority shall as required by notice in writing by the Minister of Energy remove all buildings, poles and other erections and all transmission lines, plant and other machinery and other removable equipment authorised by the licence to be erected, installed or provided and if within 12 months after being so required the Electrical Supply Authority fails or neglects to remove the same, then the same shall, without payment of any compensation vest in and become the property of the Crown and it shall be lawful for any person authorised by the Minister of Energy in that behalf, subject to compliance with section 15A of the Electricity Act 1968 to enter upon any land or premises and take possession of and remove the same or any part thereof.

11. Nothing contained in the licence, either expressly or by implication shall be deemed to authorise the Electrical Supply Authority to erect, construct or maintain any lines or works except subject to such conditions (not inconsistent with this licence) as may from time to time be lawfully imposed by any local authority within the district of which any such lines or works may be situated.

12. The systems of supply shall be as described in paragraphs (a), (b), (c), (d), (e), (f) and (j) of regulation 13 of the Electrical Supply Regulations 1984. The system of supply authorised under paragraph (j) aforesaid shall be a single-conductor earth-return system of 11 000 volts between conductor and earth, and the use thereof shall be subject to such terms and conditions as are from time to time laid down by the Deputy Secretary of the Electricity Division of the Ministry of Energy.

13. The Electrical Supply Authority shall, 6 months prior to the expiry of the term of this licence provided in clause 7 herein, make written application to the Minister of Energy for the granting of a new licence.

SCHEDULE

AREA OF SUPPLY

ALL that area in the South Auckland, Hawke's Bay and Wellington Land Districts commencing at the confluence of the Okaia Stream with the northern shore of Lake Taupo in Block XVI, Marotiri S.D. and producing generally northerly up the middle of that stream to the western boundary of Whangamata Block; thence generally northerly along that boundary and the western boundary of Tatua West Block to the southern boundary of Block IX, Atiamuri S.D.; thence easterly along the southern boundaries of said Block IX and Blocks X and XI Atiamuri S.D. to the western side of State Highway No. 1; thence generally southerly, along that western side to a point in line with the southern boundary of Tatua East No. 2 Block; thence along that right line to and along that boundary to the eastern boundary of part Tatua East No. 3A Block; thence generally southerly along that boundary to the southern boundary of Lot 2, D.P. 16198; thence south-easterly along that boundary to the north-western boundary of Tutukau West B Block; thence generally south-westerly along that boundary and generally southerly along the western boundaries of the aforementioned block to the westernmost extremity of part Tutukau East B6 Block; thence south-easterly along the south-western boundary of that block to and along a right line across Tutukau Road to the northernmost extremity of part Te Hukui Block; thence generally southerly along the western boundaries of that block to the western boundary of Section 1, Block VI, Tatua S.D.; thence generally south-westerly, south-easterly and north-easterly along the western, southern and eastern boundaries to the southern boundary of part Tahorakuri No. 3 Block; thence south-easterly along that boundary to its easternmost point; thence due east to the western boundary of Block V, Takapau S.D.; thence southerly and easterly along the western and southern boundaries of said Block V, and the southern boundaries of Blocks VI and VII, Takapau S.D., to and southerly along a right line between Trig. Waimahunga Block III, Takapau S.D. and Trig. Waiti Lookout in Block X, Takapau S.D.; and its production to the southern boundary of Block XIV, Takapau S.D.; thence easterly along the southern boundaries of said Block XIV and Block XV, Takapau S.D. to and southerly along the western boundary of Block IV, Otukotara S.D. to and easterly along the southern boundary of said Block IV and the southern boundaries of Blocks I, II and III, Heruiwi S.D.; to and southerly along a right line between Trig. F, Tiritiri, Block III, Heruiwi S.D. and Trig. B, Pukeroa, Block XI, Heruiwi S.D. to said Trig. B; thence south-easterly along a right line to Trig. Te Taumutu, Block XVI, Heruiwi S.D. being a point on the south-eastern watershed of the Rangitaiki River; thence generally southerly along that watershed to the northernmost corner of Pohokura No. 1 Block; thence southerly down the western boundaries of the last-mentioned block to the south-western corner of that block; thence westerly along the southern boundaries of Block XIII, Mangahopai West Survey District, Blocks XVI, XV, XI and XIV, Runanga Survey
