

SCHEDULE  
AREA OF SUPPLY

ALL that area in the Wellington Land District bounded by a line commencing at a point in the middle of Tremaine Avenue, north-west of the north-eastern boundary of Lot 2, D.P. 14386, being in Block VII, Kairanga Survey District, and proceeding south-easterly to and along the said north-eastern boundary and that boundary produced to the north-western boundary of Lot 1, D.P. 49032, thence north-easterly along that boundary to its intersection with the south-western boundary of Lot 4, D.P. 49032, thence south-easterly along the south-western boundary of the said Lot 4 and the extension of that boundary to a point in the middle of Mihaere Drive, thence south-westerly along the middle of said Mihaere Drive to its intersection with a line being an extension of the north-easterly boundary of Lot 2, D.P. 49032; thence along that boundary to the north-eastern boundary of said Lot 2 and Lot 1 on D.P. 52431 to part Lot 1, D.P. 26509, then generally southerly along that boundary to a point approximately 6 metres along the eastern boundary of Lot 3, D.P. 49032; thence in a straight line in a south-easterly direction to the right bank of the Manawatu River, being the south-western boundary of Lot 2, D.P. 10732; thence generally south-westerly, southerly, westerly and again south-westerly along the said right bank to the north-eastern boundary of part Lot 4 of D.P. 2826, Block XIV, Kairanga Survey District as outlined in black ink on the aerial print NZE No. 2092 (sheet 21) flown on 3/4/81; thence north-westerly along the north-eastern boundaries of said part Lot 4, Lot 2, D.P. 25577, Lots 9, 8 and 6 of D.P. 24772, across Dittmer Drive, Lot 2, D.P. 40942, Lot 12, D.P. 34962, across Wharite Place, Lot 7, D.P. 34962, and Lot 1 of D.P. 19391 and Lots 8, 7 and 6 of D.P. 24622, to the north-eastern corner of said Lot 6; thence north-westerly along a right line, crossing Sheffield Street, to a point on the north-western side of College Street, also being the south-western corner of Lot 1, D.P. 23603; thence north-westerly along the south-western boundaries of said Lot 1 and Lots 10, 9, 8, 7 and 6 of D.P. 23603 to the south-eastern boundary of Lot 97, D.P. 20548 (Recreation Reserve), south-westerly along the last-mentioned boundary to a line being the south-easterly production of the south-western boundary of Lot 62, D.P. 20548; thence north-westerly along said line, the said south-western boundary across Rugby Street, the south-western boundaries of Lots 28, 29, 30, 31, 32, 33, 34, 35, 36 and 37 of D.P. 16886, across Wakefield Street, Lots 39, 40, 41, 42 and 43 of D.P. 16886, and part Section 558, and the last-mentioned boundary produced to the middle of Pioneer Highway; thence in a northerly direction across Lot 3, D.P. 29419 (which is a Recreation Reserve) then across Marriner Street to a point on the southern corner of part Lot 2, D.P. 25599 (Recreation Reserve); thence north-westerly along the north-eastern boundaries of Lots 72, 71, 70, 69, 68, 67, 66, 65, 64, 63, 62, 61 and 60, D.P. 25218, north-easterly along the south-eastern boundaries of Lots 57, 56 and 55, D.P. 24258, north-westerly along the north-eastern boundary of Lot 55, D.P. 24258 across Ronberg Street to the south-western corner of Lot 40, D.P. 24258; thence north-westerly along the south-western boundary of said Lot 40 and the south-western boundaries of Lots 83, 39, 82 and 81, D.P. 24258 to the south-eastern corner of Lot 198, D.P. 24258, north-westerly along the north-eastern boundaries of said Lot 198, northerly across Lot 84, D.P. 24258 (Kawau Stream) to the south-western corner of Lot 29, D.P. 24699, north-westerly along the south-western boundary of said Lot 29; thence across Ellesmere Crescent, north-westerly along the south-western boundaries of Lots 30, 31, 32 and 33, D.P. 24699, north-easterly along the south-eastern boundary of Lot 36, D.P. 26239, north-westerly along the north-eastern boundary of said Lot 36, and across Pembroke Street to the south-western corner of Lot 165, D.P. 26433; thence north-westerly along the south-western and western boundaries of said Lot 165 and Lot 164, D.P. 26433, north-westerly along the south-western boundary of Lot 149, D.P. 26433 across Jackson Avenue to the south-western corner of Lot 132, D.P. 26433, and north-westerly along the south-western boundaries of said Lot 132 and Lots 144, 143 and 142, D.P. 26433; thence north-easterly along the north-western boundary of the said Lot 142, north-westerly along the north-eastern boundary of Lot 141, D.P. 26433, across Stephens Crescent to the south-western corner of Lot 3, D.P. 26969 and north-westerly along the south-western boundary of Lot 3, D.P. 26969; thence across Lot 170, D.P. 26433 to and along the south-western boundaries of part Lot 140, D.P. 22273, part Lot 7, D.P. 7438 (Mangaone Stream), Lots 83, 82, 81, 80, 79 and 78, D.P. 22311 and across Havelock Avenue to and along the south-western boundaries of Lot 1, D.P. 34909, Lot 76, D.P. 22311, Lots 10, 9, 8, 7, 6, 5, 4, 3, 2 and 1 of D.P. 20277, Lots 6, 5, 4, 3, 2 and 1 of D.P. 18054 and Lot 24 of D.P. 14156 and the last-mentioned boundary produced to the middle of Tremaine Avenue; thence north-easterly along the middle of said Avenue to the point of commencement.

The said area being more particularly shown outlined in black on the plan numbered NZE 2092 (sheets 1-23) deposited in the office of the Electricity Division of the Ministry of Energy at Wellington.

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Rotorua Area Electricity Authority Electricity Supply Licence 1985

I, Robert James Tizard, Minister of Energy, acting pursuant to section 20 of the Electricity Act 1968 hereby license Rotorua Area Electricity Authority hereinafter called the Electrical Supply Authority to supply electricity, and to lay, construct, put up, place and use all electric lines and works which may from time to time be required for the distribution and supply of electricity within the area specified in the Schedule hereto.

This licence is issued subject to the following conditions:

CONDITIONS

1. This licence may be cited as the Rotorua Area Electricity Authority Electricity Supply Licence 1985.

2. The Electrical Supply Authority shall comply with the provisions of this licence, the Electricity Act 1968 and all enactments made in amendment of or substitution for that Act, any Electrical Codes of Practice made under that Act, the Electrical Supply Regulations 1984, the Electrical Wiring Regulations 1976 and all regulations made in amendment of or substitution for any of those regulations.

3. Any notice to be given to the Electrical Supply Authority shall be sufficient if sent by registered post to the offices of the Electrical Supply Authority.

4. Any notice to be given on the part of the Minister of Energy shall be sufficient if given in writing signed by the Minister or by any person purporting to act on behalf of or under the authority of the Minister.

5. Any notice to be given to the Minister of Energy shall be sufficient if given in writing to or sent by registered post letter addressed to the Secretary of Energy, Ministry of Energy, Wellington.

6. This licence shall not be construed as granting a consent to generate electricity pursuant to section 25 of the Electricity Act 1968.

7. This licence shall come into force on the 1st day of April 1985 and shall continue in force for a period of 21 years from that date unless it is sooner lawfully determined in accordance with clauses 8 or 9 hereof.

8. The Governor-General in Council may pursuant to section 22 of the Electricity Act 1968 cancel this licence if the Electrical Supply Authority is in breach of the provisions contained in clause 2 of these conditions.

9. This licence may be cancelled by the Minister of Energy at the request of or with the consent of the Electrical Supply Authority.

10. At the expiry or cancellation of this licence, the Electrical Supply Authority shall as required by notice in writing by the Minister of Energy remove all buildings, poles and other erections and all transmission lines, plant and other machinery and other removable equipment authorised by the licence to be erected, installed or provided and if within 12 months after being so required the Electrical Supply Authority fails or neglects to remove the same, then the same shall, without payment of any compensation vest in and become the property of the Crown and it shall be lawful for any person authorised by the Minister of Energy in that behalf, subject to compliance with section 15A of the Electricity Act 1968 to enter upon any land or premises and take possession of and remove the same or any part thereof.

11. Nothing contained in the licence, either expressly or by implication shall be deemed to authorise the Electrical Supply Authority to erect, construct or maintain any lines or works except subject to such conditions (not inconsistent with this licence) as may from time to time be lawfully imposed by any local authority within the district of which any such lines or works may be situated.

12. The systems of supply shall be as described in paragraphs (a), (b), (c), (d), (e) and (f) of regulation 13 of the Electrical Supply Regulations 1984.

13. The Electrical Supply Authority shall, 6 months prior to the expiry of the term of this licence provided in clause 7 herein, make written application to the Minister of Energy for the granting of a new licence.

AREA OF SUPPLY

ALL that area in the counties of Matamata, Taupo, and Tauranga, and the districts of Rotorua and Whakatane, commencing at a point on the south-western boundary of Section 3, Block II, Rotorua Survey District where that point is intersected by a right line between westernmost corner of Section 1, D.P. S. 9825, Block V, Horohoro Survey District and Trig. 27, Puwhenua, Block VII, Tapapa East Survey District. From that point on the south-western boundary aforesaid and proceeding south-easterly to the north-western boundary of Section 13, Block III, Rotorua Survey District; thence north-easterly along that boundary and its production to the middle of the Ohaupara Stream; thence easterly, generally down the middle
