Boundary Road: from a point 400 metres measured easterly generally along the said road from Opaheke Road to Hunua Road.

Clevedon Road: from the eastern boundary of Papakura City to a point 480 metres measured easterly generally along Clevedon Road to the said boundary.

Croskery Road.

Dominion Road: from a point 300 metres measured southerly generally along the said road from Settlement Road to Hunua Road.

Hunua Road: from a point 420 metres measured southerly gener-ally along Hunua Road from Settlement Road to the eastern boundary of Papakura City.
