Number and Title of Specification

DZ 5434 2nd Edition. Code of practice for LPG vehicle refuelling stations. \$10.

This standard was originally circulated for comment in November 1982. As a result of comments received a second edition of the draft has been prepared and is now available for comment.

The standard is sponsored by the Ministry of Energy as part of their policy for promoting the substitution of imported fuels with indigenous fuels.

The purpose of the code is to provide a common basis for the installers, approving authorities and advisory agencies to design and assess the engineering and safety requirements of LPG refuelling stations and so promote rapid but safe expansion of the use of LPG as an automotive fuel.
