HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to sections 10 and 11 of the Electric Power Boards Act 1925, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

### ORDER

- **1. Title and commencement**—(1) This order may be cited as the Marlborough Electric Power Board Representation Order 1986.
- (2) This order shall come into force on the day after the date of its publication in the *Gazette*.
- 2. Application—(1) This order shall apply in respect of the triennial election of members of the Marlborough Electric Power Board to be held on the 11th day of October 1986, and every subsequent election of any member or members of that Board.
- (2) Notwithstanding the revocation of the orders specified in clause 6 of this order, those orders shall apply in respect of any election before the 1986 triennial general election as if this order had not been made.
- **3.** Combined districts—Where the names of 2 or more constituent districts within the district of the Marlborough Electric Power Board are shown bracketed together in the first column of the First Schedule to this order, those constituent districts are hereby combined into a combined district for the purpose of the election of representatives on the Board of that district.
