NOTICE OF INTENTION TO TAKE LAND

NOTICE is hereby given that the Napier City Council proposes under the provisions of the Public Works Act 1981 to execute certain public works namely road and for the purposes of such public works and land described in the Schedule hereto is required to be taken for road.
