- (2) This order shall come into force on the 1st day of December 1986.
 - 2. Interpretation—In this order—

"The Act" means the Harbours Act 1950:

"The Director-General" means the Director-General of Lands.

- **3. Grant of Control**—There is hereby granted to the Director-General for a period of 21 years from the 1st day of December 1986 and ending with the 30th day of November 2007 control of the lakeshore and lakebed described in the Schedule to this order.
- **4.** Conditions of Grant—The grant of control conferred by clause 3 of this order is subject to the following conditions—

 - (b) All money received by the Director-General in the performance or exercise of the functions, duties, or powers conferred on him by this order in respect of lakeshore and lakebed to which this order applies, shall, after the deduction of any expenditure incurred by the Director-General in the performance or exercise of those functions, duties, or powers, be applied to the construction, repair or improvement of facilities in respect of that lakeshore and lakebed and not otherwise.
