HIS EXCELLENCY THE ADMINISTRATOR OF THE GOVERNMENT IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to section 25 of the Finance Act (No. 2) 1942, His Excellency the Administrator of the Government, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

#### ORDER

**1. Title and commencement**—(1) This order may be cited as the Wellington Harbour Board Employees Superannuation Scheme Order 1986.

(2) This order shall come into force on the 14th day after the date of its notification in the *Gazette*.

**2.** Consent to superannuation scheme—Consent is hereby given to the Wellington Harbour Board to establish a superannuation scheme for the benefit of persons in its employment and their dependants, subject to the following conditions:

- (a) The scheme shall apply only in respect of employees who are not eligible to join the scheme for which consent was given in the Harbour Boards Employees Superannuation Scheme Order 1985\*:
- (b) The only benefits of the scheme shall be lump sum payments on the death or disability (including early retirement due to disability) of an employee:
- (c) The benefits of the scheme shall be provided only by means of life insurance.
