Approved Operating Procedures for CNG Daughter Stations

PURSUANT to section 61 of the Gas Act 1982 and to regulation 37 of the Gas Industry Regulations 1984 I, David James Green, Chief Inspecting Engineer, hereby give notice that with effect from 1 March 1987, the construction, maintenance and operation of CNG vehicle refuelling stations supplied with gas other than by a franchise holder ("daughter stations"), shall be in accordance with the following approved procedure.

1. No person shall supply gas to or through any part of a daughter station on which gasfitting has been carried out after 1 March 1987, unless authority to do so has been given by a franchise holder gas installation inspector.

2. As soon as practicable after completion of such gasfitting, a gas installation inspector shall certify that in the inspector's opinion the work has been carried out in a satisfactory manner and the installation is safe to use.

3. Nothing in any such certificate shall relieve the person who owns or uses the daughter station from any liability under regulation 33 of the Gas Industry Regulations 1984 for remedying any defect that may be discovered subsequent to the issue of that certificate and which, if not remedied, would constitute a hazard or be in breach of the requirements of approved standards.
