

4. The Water Recreation (The Elbow-Tuakau, Waikato River) Notice 1980* is hereby revoked.

SCHEDULE

FIRSTLY all that area of water in the Waikato River between a line across the river in an east direction projected from the north-east corner of Lot 1, as depicted on D.P. 45711, and a line across the river from the old building known as the Whitebait Factory, to a point on the opposite shore known as Te Pahikairarua.

Secondly all that area of the Waikato River between a line drawn on a 002° true direction from the eastern corner of Smeeds Road landing, to a point of land on the opposite shore known as "Little Rock", and a line across the river in an east direction projected from the north-east corner of Lot 1, as depicted on D.P. 45711 (being 280 metres down stream of Elbow Road).

Thirdly, all that area of water in the Waikato River between a line across the river in an east direction projected from the north-east corner of Lot 1, as depicted on D.P. 45711, and a southerly line across the Waikato River in tangent with the north-eastern extremity of Motutieke Island.

The areas described firstly and secondly in the Schedule are further shown on plan M.D. 16002. The areas described thirdly in the Schedule are shown on plan M.D. 16387 and deposited in the office of the Ministry of Transport at Wellington.
