

of Shipleys Road, Johns Road and Russley Road to the middle of Yaldhurst Road; thence south-easterly generally along the middle lines of Yaldhurst Road, Riccarton Road, Hansons Lane, Blenheim Road and Annex Road and the middle line of Annex Road to the middle of Wigram Road, thence south-westerly along the middle of that road to the middle of Halswell Junction Road; thence north-westerly along that road to a point in line with the south-eastern boundary of Lot 2, D.P. 3256, Block XIV, Christchurch S.D.; thence south-westerly to and along that boundary and its production to the middle of Knights Stream; thence south-easterly generally along the middle of that stream and the Halswell River to a point in line with the southern boundary of part Rural Section 1593; thence south-easterly to and along that boundary and the southern boundaries of Rural Sections 772, 1594, 1100, 1913 and 1592 to and south-westerly along the north-western boundary of part Lot 1, D.P. 43283 to the south-western boundary of said part Lot 1; thence south-easterly along the south-western boundaries of said part Lot 1 and Lot 1, D.P. 16613 and Lot 1, D.P. 14689 to the westernmost corner of Lot 4, D.P. 43283; thence north-easterly along the north-western boundaries of said Lot 3 and part Lot 1, D.P. 22535 and the last-mentioned boundary produced to the middle of Kennedy's Bush Road, thence generally south-easterly along the middle of Kennedy's Bush Road to a point in line with the generally northern boundary of part Rural Section 33743X; thence south-easterly to and along that boundary to the northern side of the Summit Road; thence easterly and northerly along the northern and eastern sides of said Road to the southernmost corner of Lot 4, D.P. 12886; thence along the south-western boundary of said Lot 4 and the south-western and north-western boundaries of Lot 1, D.P. 18411 and the last-mentioned boundary produced to and along the north-eastern side of Worsleys Road to the westernmost corner of Rural Section 2231, thence north-easterly along that boundary to and south-easterly and north-easterly along the western and south-eastern boundaries of Rural Section 31528 to and along the south-eastern boundary of Rural Section 34652 and the last-mentioned boundary produced to the western side of Dyers Pass Road; thence generally southerly along that roadside, across the Summit Road to the summit of the Port Hills; thence generally north-easterly along the summit of the Port Hills to a point in line with the north-eastern boundary of Maori Reserve 875, Rapaki; thence south-easterly to and along that boundary and its production to the sea coast in Lyttelton Harbour; thence south-easterly along a right line across Lyttelton Harbour to a point on the sea coast in line with Church Gully in Church Bay; thence easterly, southerly and westerly generally along the sea coast (including Banks Peninsula) to the point of commencement.

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*Egmont Electric Power Board Electricity Supply Licence 1986*

I, Robert James Tizard, Minister of Energy, acting pursuant to section 20 of the Electricity Act 1968, hereby license Egmont Electric Power Board hereinafter called the Electrical Supply Authority to supply electricity, and to lay, construct, put up, place and use all electric lines and works which may from time to time be required for the distribution and supply of electricity within the area specified in the Schedule hereto.

This licence is issued subject to the following conditions:

CONDITIONS

1. This licence may be cited as the "Egmont Electric Power Board Electricity Supply Licence 1986".
2. The Electrical Supply Authority shall comply with the provisions of this licence, the Electricity Act 1968 and all enactments made in amendment of or substitution for that Act, any Electrical Codes of Practice made under that Act, the Electrical Supply Regulations 1984, the Electrical Wiring Regulations 1976 and all regulations made in amendment of or substitution for any of those regulations.
3. Any notice to be given to the Electrical Supply Authority shall be sufficient if sent by registered post letter to the offices of the Electrical Supply Authority.
4. Any notice to be given on the part of the Minister of Energy shall be sufficient if given in writing signed by the Minister or by any person acting under the authority of the Minister.
5. Any notice to be given to the Minister of Energy shall be sufficient if given in writing to or sent by registered post letter addressed to the Secretary of Energy, Ministry of Energy, Wellington.
6. This licence shall not be construed as granting a consent to generate electricity pursuant to section 25 of the Electricity Act 1968.

7. This licence shall come into force on the 1st day of April 1986 and shall continue in force for a period of 21 years from that date unless it is sooner lawfully determined in accordance with clauses 8 or 9 hereof.

8. The Governor-General in Council may pursuant to section 22 of the Electricity Act 1968 cancel this licence if the Electrical Supply Authority is in breach of the provisions contained in clause 2 of these conditions.

9. This licence may be cancelled by the Minister of Energy at the request of or with the consent of the Electrical Supply Authority.

10. At the expiry or cancellation of this licence, the Electrical Supply Authority shall as required by notice in writing by the Minister of Energy remove all buildings, poles and other erections and all transmission lines, plant and other machinery and other removable equipment authorised by the licence to be erected, installed or provided and if within 12 months after being so required the Electrical Supply Authority fails or neglects to remove the same, then the same shall, without payment of any compensation vest in and become the property of the Crown and it shall be lawful for any person authorised by the Minister of Energy in that behalf, subject to compliance with section 15A of the Electricity Act 1968 to enter upon any land or premises and take possession of and remove the same or any part thereof.

11. Nothing contained in the licence, either expressly or by implication shall be deemed to authorise the Electrical Supply Authority to erect, construct or maintain any lines or works except subject to such conditions (not inconsistent with this licence) as may from time to time be lawfully imposed by any local authority within the district of which any such lines or works may be situated.

12. The systems of supply shall be as described in paragraphs (a), (b), (c), (d), (e), (f) and (h) of Regulation 13 of the Electrical Supply Regulations 1984.

13. The Electrical Supply Authority shall, 6 months prior to the expiry of the term of this licence provided in clause 7 herein, make written application to the Minister of Energy for the granting of a new licence.

AREA OF SUPPLY

ALL that area in the Taranaki and Wellington Land Districts bounded by a line commencing on the sea coast at the right bank of the Hangatahua (Stony) River and proceeding generally south-easterly along that bank to a point in line with the middle line of Forest Road in Block XI, Cape S.D. thence south-easterly along a right line to the summit of Mt Egmont; thence southerly along another right line to the north-eastern corner of Section 10, Block V, Kaipokonui S.D.; thence along the north-eastern and western boundaries of said Section 10, the western boundary of Section 11, the western and southern boundaries of part Section 12, the western boundary of Section 15 and the western and southern boundaries of Section 14, all the aforesaid Sections being in Block V, Kaipokonui S.D.; to and southerly along the eastern boundary of Section 8 crossing Opunake Road, to the northern boundary of part Section 14; thence along the northern and western boundaries of said part Section 14 and the western and southern boundaries of another part Section 14 to and southerly along the western side of Auroa Road, crossing Eltham Road to the northern boundary of part Lot 1, D.P. 2329; thence along the northern and western boundaries of the said part Lot 1 and the western boundary of Section 36, all the aforementioned being in Block IX, Kaipokonui S.D. to the northern boundary of Section 8, Block XIII, Kaipokonui S.D.; thence easterly along said northern boundary to and along the western and southern boundaries of Section 18, Block XIII aforesaid and that boundary produced to the eastern side of Auroa Road, southerly along said roadside to the southern boundary of Section 1, Block XIV, Kaipokonui S.D., thence along the said southern boundary and along the southern and eastern boundaries of Lot 1, D.P. 2769 and the western boundary of Subdivision 2 of 99 to and along the southern boundary of Section 77, Block X aforesaid and that boundary produced to the eastern side of Mangawhero Road; southerly along said roadside to the northern boundary of Section 18, Block XIV aforesaid; thence easterly along said northern boundary and along the northern boundary of Lot 1, D.P. 6269, across Rowan Road, the northern boundaries of Section 35, Block XV aforesaid and Lot 1, D.P. 3110 and the last-mentioned boundary produced to the eastern side of Manaia Road; northerly along said roadside to the northern boundary of Section 116, Block XI, Kaipokonui S.D.; thence along the northern and eastern boundaries of said Section 116 and the western boundary of Section 125, Block XI aforesaid to the northern side of Neill Road; easterly along said road side to a point in line with the eastern boundary of Lot 1, D.P. 6941; thence southerly to and along that boundary and along the eastern and southern boundaries of part Section 4, the western boundary of Section 8, the western and southern boundaries of Section 10, the western boundary of Section 12 and the western boundary of Section 13 all the aforementioned being in Block XV, Kaipokonui S.D. and the last-mentioned boundary produced across the Opunake Branch Railway to the northern boundary of Section
