PURSUANT to subsection (6) of section 5 of the Education Lands Act 1949, I, The Most Reverend Sir Paul Alfred Reeves, the Governor-General of New Zealand, hereby proclaim and declare that the land described in the Schedule hereto, being an area vested in the Otago Education Board as a site for a school, shall be vested in Her Majesty the Queen, freed and discharged from every educational trust affecting the same, but subject to all leases, encumbrances, liens, or easements affecting the same at the date hereof.

WHEREAS by Deeds of Grant, dated the first and ninth days of June 1875, the lands described in the Schedule hereto, were granted to the Superintendent of the Province of Otago under the Public Reserves Acts 1854 and 1862 in trust for the establishment and maintenance of a University in the City of Dunedin in the Province of Otago, and of Public Schools in different parts of the Province and for the more general advancement of education in the said Province

AND WHEREAS by section 9 of the Abolition of Provinces Act 1875, the said lands were vested in Her Majesty the Queen, in trust for the aforesaid purposes

AND WHEREAS the said lands are not required for the purposes for which they are held

NOW THEREFORE pursuant to section 15 (5) of the Education Lands Act 1949, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby declares that the lands in the Schedule hereto shall, as from the date hereof, be Crown land subject to the Land Act 1948 freed and discharged from every educational trust affecting the same.
