EXPLANATORY NOTE: This exemption notice provides for the exemption of:

- those goods which have been subject to licence on demand for twelve months as a result of global tendering;
- wool tops under the Textile Industry Development Plan;
- certain consumer electrical goods and blank sound recording tape other than video;
- amendments to existing exemptions to maintain alignment with the Customs Tariff; and
- exemptions under the ANZCERT Agreement to provide that goods subject to licence on demand are exempt from Australia.
