HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to section 4 of the Disabled Persons Employment Promotion Act 1960, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting on the recommendation of the Minister of Labour made after consultation with the unions, associations, and organisations referred to in section 5 of that Act, and by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

### ORDER

- 1. Title—This order may be cited as the New Zealand Society for the Intellectually Handicapped (Incorporated), Canterbury Branch Order 1986.
- 2. Exemption—The New Zealand Society for the Intellectually Handicapped (Incorporated), Canterbury Branch an organisation approved\* under the former name of Intellectually Handicapped Children's Society (Incorporated), Canterbury Branch by the Minister of Labour under section 3 of the Disabled Persons Employment Act 1960, is hereby granted exemption in respect of its sheltered workshop at 150 Ferry Road, Christchurch, from—
  - (a) All the provisions of every award and agreement that would otherwise apply to persons employed in that workshop; and

- (b) The Minimum Wage Act 1945, the Holidays Act 1981, and sections 10 (2) (b) and 15 of the Factories and Commercial Premises Act 1981.
- 3. Revocation—The New Zealand Society for the Intellectually Handicapped (Incorporated) Canterbury Branch Order 1978† is hereby revoked.
