The post-nominal letters may be used in the context of any occasion or matter connected with the Order, or for inclusion in any publication of a biographical nature. The ribbon of the Order when worn alone will be 38 mm (1½ inches) in width, for all grades except Grade VI, with a small silver cross in the centre. Rosettes and buttons denoting Membership of the Order are not worn when insignia or miniature badges are worn.
