*Notice of Intention to Take Land for a Limited Access Road in  
the City of Upper Hutt*

NOTICE is hereby given that it is proposed, under the provisions of the Public Works Act 1981, to take the land described in the Schedule hereto for a limited access road, which is to vest in the Crown and is to be used for the realignment of State Highway 2 owing to the construction of the new Mangaroa Bridge Road.
