Amending An Order In Council Known as The Waimea East Irrigation District Order 1982

At Wellington this 17th day of August 1987 Present:

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to section 208 (2) of the Public Works Act 1981, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice of the Executive Council, and on the recommendation of the Minister of Works and Development hereby amends the Order in Council dated the 17th day of May 1982 and published in the New Zealand Gazette of 27 May 1982, No. 56, at page 1685, known as the Waimea East Irrigation District Order 1982 by omitting part 3 of the Order and the Second Schedule and substituting the following:

"3. It is hereby declared that the annual basic charge payable in respect of irrigable land within the district shall be \$135 per hectare and that the annual water availability charge payable in respect of water supplied shall be \$65/water unit where a water unit is 1000 cubic metres of water and the minimum annual water availability charge is as for 5 water units per assessed irrigable hectare."
