THE Minister of Internal Affairs may, in accordance with section 35 of the above Act, grant licences to conduct lotteries with prizes exceeding \$500 in aggregate and, inter alia, grant a licence either unconditionally or subject to such conditions as he may specify. This notice outlines the maximum lottery prize limits for:

(a) *Standard Lotteries:*

regional	\$28,600
national	\$38,500

(b) *Snowball Lotteries:*

local	\$42,900
regional	\$52,800
national	\$62,700

(minor draws are not to exceed \$2,200 each.)
