(c) Except in the case of a casual vacancy or as otherwise provided in this notice, every member shall hold office until the 15th day of November in the third year after that member's election of appointment, and if on the 15th day of November the appointment or election of the successor has not been notified to the council, that member shall continue to hold office until the date on which that appointment of election is so notified.

(d) If any member

(i) Dies; or

(ii) Resigns office by giving written notice addressed to the council or to the chairman or the secretary thereof; or

(iii) Is absent without leave from the meetings of the council for 3 consecutive months; or

(iv) While holding office becomes ineligible to remain a member by reason of disability, insolvency, neglect of duty or misconduct, the casual vacancy so created shall be filled as soon as practicable thereafter by the appointment or election of a member in the manner in which the vacating member was appointed or elected. The member appointed or elected to fill the vacancy shall hold office for the residue of the term of office of the member whom that person replaces.

(e) The powers of the council shall not be affected by vacancy in the membership thereof.
