This notice may be cited as the Traffic (Otamatea County) Notice No. 1, 1987.

The area and roads specified in the First Schedule are declared to be closely populated localities for the purposes of section 52 of the Transport Act 1962.

The roads specified in the Second Schedule are declared to be 70 kilometres an hour speed limit areas pursuant to regulation 21 (2) of the Traffic Regulations 1976.

The Traffic (Otamatea County) Notice No. 1, 1984, signed the 27th day of February 1984*, issued pursuant to section 52 of the Transport Act 1962, and regulation 21 (2) of the Traffic Regulations 1976 is revoked.

First Schedule

Situated within Otamatea County at Mangawhai:

Insley Street.

Moir Street: from a point 50 metres measured westerly, generally, along the said street from Leslie Street to its north eastern end.
